


## AVERAGE BENEFITS PAID FOR UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE CLAIMS





#### PERCENT CHANGE IN UNEMPLOYMENT FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR\*





## CHANGE IN UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FROM SEPTEMBER OF PREVIOUS YEAR\*




