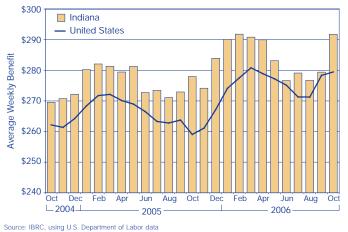
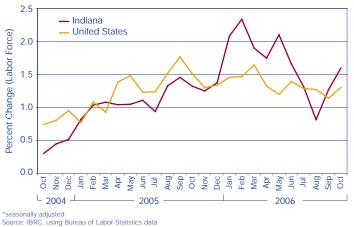

PERCENT CHANGE IN LABOR FORCE FROM PREVIOUS YEAR*




CHANGE IN EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRY SUPER-SECTOR, 2005 TO 2006*

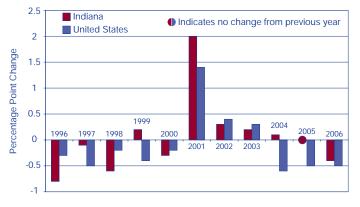
